

1. What are cookies?

Cookies are small data files, that a website you visit, like ours, may install and store on your PC or your mobile device (tablet, smartphone, laptop). Thanks to cookies, the website saves your actions during browsing.

2. Functions of cookies

According to their type, our website's cookies are used either to update the Cookies Policy and personal data, to control the appearance of the Cookies Policy or to check that you have been informed about the use of cookies by pressing the "I have been informed" button. Our website uses only the technically required cookies and not others that are used for commercial or advertising purposes.

3. Types of cookies

The cookies used by our website are exclusively the technically required ones. The cookies of the previewed website are installed by the website that you visit and they are read only by it. The website does not use third-party services, therefore these are not installed on your device, the so-called third-party cookies (Google Analytics, Facebook etc.). Every time you visit our website, you will be asked to state that you have been "informed" about the use of technically required cookies. If you willingly select this option, our website will save it and it will be aware that you have been informed for a certain period. This way, you will not be required to be informed again about the use of cookies when you browse our website during the same visit; however, our cookies policy is available to you at any time.

4. Legal status of using and saving cookies

The installation and use of cookies is specifically governed by the law (article 4 par. 4 Law 3471/2006 that has incorporated the European Directive 2002/58/EC ePrivacy). Without prejudice to compliance to obligations arising by privacy protection, in accordance with the aforementioned law, every website is allowed to store data of technical nature, that is necessary for transmitting information.

5. How we use cookies

We use the following types of cookies:

Our website does not show content from external (third-party) providers such as Google Analytics, YouTube, Facebook, Twitter etc.

6. Obtaining the visitor’s consent

The visitor’s consent is not required, as our website uses only the technically required cookies, which are always enabled for the website’s operation.

In the information text about the use of technically required cookies, there is a link which leads to the current cookies policy of our website, in which every user can read all the information in terms of cookies’ functions, that the website uses.

7. Controlling and deleting cookies

You may delete cookies according to your preference. You may delete all cookies from your computer, as well as set most browsers in a way that they do not allow the installation of cookies.

This policy will be reviewed regularly so that it complies with the directives of Supervision Authorities and the latest legislative and case-law progress.
