

Our History

Olympus Bank was created on the base of two Greek Cooperative Banks, the Cooperative Bank of Drama and the Cooperative Bank of Evros, operating in North Greece in the region of East Macedonia and Thrace.

Cooperative Bank of Drama LLC began its operations as a credit institution in 1999 in the Drama region and Cooperative Bank of Evros began its operations in 1996 in the Evros region.

In 2018 the merger of the two cooperative banks took place under the name of Cooperative Bank of Drama LLC and the customers of both banks were provided service through the existing branch network and web banking.

The Bank was created by the local communities with the initial concept of a Bank serving the needs of these communities with flexibility, direct participation in decisions and a commitment to transparency as key components.

In 2022 the Bank name was changed to Olympus Bank, with the vision of further promoting the interests of its clients, while maintaining a robust organization that is effective, professional and responsive. These goals will be achieved through the launch of new technologies, the introduction of innovative products and the creation of value-added modern banking services, ensuring an exceptional digital client experience.
